

18th Annual Cardboard Boat Race

August 11, 2018

Rules:

- At least one person must be able to float in a boat no smaller than 1' x 1 x 3'
- The entire craft must be made of corrugated, non-coated cardboard (sheets, blocks & tubes are allowed)
- Human power or wind must be used for propulsion (no motors)
- Any material paddles may be used
- You cannot wrap boat in duct tape or plastic
- Lifejackets are required and must be provided by the participant

Materials Allowed:

- Duct tape/masking tape (on seams, joints and corners only) – polyurethane/one-part sealers
- Latex paint – wood glue/liquid nails
- Silicone or latex caulking (on open corrugated ends only)

Materials Not Allowed:

- Two-part epoxy paints or glues – fiberglass - wood - styrofoam
- Wax- Metal- Staples- Plastics- Plastic Bags
